- Vote on changes to the bylaws

Can Youth Serve?

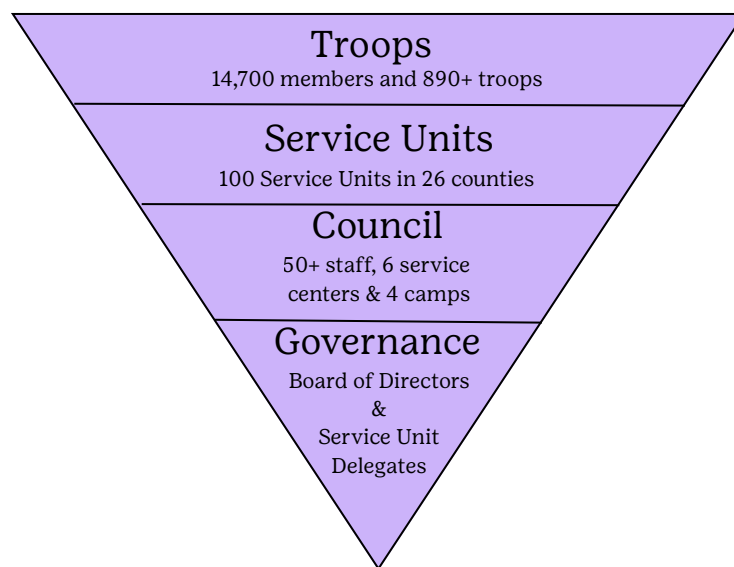
Yes—NYPENN members 14+ can be Delegates!
